

EAGLE SHADOW DAY

The Eagle Shadow Day will give your 3rd - 8th grade student the opportunity to spend a day attending classes with a current OLGCS Mentor student. In addition to attending classes, your student will meet other students and teachers, eat lunch in our cafeteria and experience life at Our Lady of Grace Catholic School first-hand.

Arrival:

On the day of the visit, please arrive by 7:50 am at our School Office. Parents are required to sign Shadow students in, leave a contact telephone number and to order a complimentary hot lunch (your student may also bring his/her own lunch). Upon arrival, enter through the Education Center doors that are in the back of the church in the north side of the parking lot. (Lot closest to the playground)

Parking:

There is visitor parking in the back of the church in the north side of the parking lot (lot closest to the playground). We recommend parents accompany your student into the building where you can check-in your student.

Lunch:

A hot lunch is "on us" for this day! You may also bring a packed lunch if your child prefers.

What to Bring:

Your student is welcome to bring homework or a book to read in case his/her Mentor host has a test or quiz in a class. Please bring a sweatshirt or sweater as some of the classrooms are cooler.

End of Day Pick-up:

Your student will be ready for pick up at approximately 3:15 pm. You can park in the Church parking lot at the back of the church. We allow Shadow families to park in the Church lot so that you aren't stuck in dismissal lines. Teachers will bring all students out at the end of the day and you may walk over and retrieve your students at this time. Please feel free to leave parking lot immediately. You are not required to wait for the rest of the school to depart.

Attire for EAGLE Shadow Days:

Boys: Khakis or nice pants, no jeans permitted; polo, collared shirt or sweater

Girls: Khaki's, nice pants, or dress / skirt, not shorter than 2" above the knee, are allowed, no jeans permitted; polo, nice shirt or sweater. No "hoodies" or leggings as pants are permitted.
